I have been justified — **completely** forgiven and made righteous (Rom 5:1)
I died with Christ and died to the power of sin's rule over my life (Rom 6:1-6)
I have been placed into Christ by God's doing (1 Cor 1:30)
I have received the Spirit of God into my life that I might know the things **freely given** to me by God (1 Cor 2:12)
I have been given the **mind of Christ** (1 Cor 2:16)
I have been **bought with a price**; I am not my own; I belong to God (1 Cor 6: 9,20)
I have been **established, anointed** and **sealed** by God in Christ, and I have been given the Holy Spirit as a pledge **guaranteeing** my inheritance to come (2 Cor 1:21; Eph 1:13,14)
Since I have died, I no longer live for myself, but for Christ (2 Cor 5:14,15)
I have been **made righteous** (2 Cor 5:2 1)

I have been crucified with Christ and it is **no longer** I who live, but Christ in me. The life I am now living is **Christ's life** (Gal 2:20)
I have been blessed with **every spiritual blessing** (Eph 1:3)
I was **chosen** in Christ **before** the foundation of the world, to be holy and am **without blame** before Him (Eph 1:4)
I was predestined — determined by God — to be **adopted** as God's child (Eph 1:5)
I have been **raised up** and seated with Christ in Heaven (Eph 2:6)

I have been **rescued** from the domain of Satan's rule and **transferred** to the

Kingdom of Christ (Col 1:13)

I have been redeemed and forgiven of all my sins. The debt against me has been **cancelled** (Col 1:14)

Christ himself is in me (Col 1:27)

I am **firmly rooted** in Christ and am now being built in Him (Col 2:7)

I have been spiritually circumcised (Col 2:11)

I have been buried, raised and **made alive** with Christ (Col 2:12,13)

I have been given a spirit of power, love and self-discipline

(2 Tim 1:7)

I have been saved and set apart **according to God's doing** (2 Tim 1:9; Titus 3:5)

Because I am sanctified and am one with the sanctifier, **He is not ashamed** to call me brother or sister (Heb 2:11)

I have been given **exceedingly great** and **precious promises** by God by which I am a **partaker** of God's divine nature (2 Pet 1:4)

BEING SET APART FOR GOD

Today I choose to **deny myself, take up** my cross, and **follow Jesus**. (Lk 9:23) I **choose** to lose my life for Christ and for the gospel. (Mark 8:35) I count the cost and give up **everything** I have to be Christ's disciple. (Lk 14:28, 33) I say to God, "**Here am I. Send me!**" and "Speak, for your servant is listening." (Isa6:8; 1 Samuel 3:10)

I am **God's workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which **God prepared** in advance for me to do. (Eph 2:10) I am **not my own**; I was bought at a price. Therefore I will honor God with **my body**. (1 Cor 6:19-20) I have been crucified with Christ and I **no longer live**, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live **by faith** in the Son of God, who **loved** me and **gave** Himself for me. (Gal 2:20) I eagerly expect and hope that I will **in no way** be ashamed, but will have **sufficient courage** so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. (Phil 1:20-21)

In view of God's **abundant mercy** toward me, I offer my body as a **living sacrifice**, holy and pleasing to God this is my true act of worship. I will **not conform** any longer to the pattern of this world, but I will **be transformed** by the **renewing** of my mind. Then I will be able to **test and approve** what God's will is-His good, pleasing and perfect will. (Rom 12:1-2) If I am out of my mind, it is for the sake of God. For Christ's love **compels me**, because I am convinced that one died for all. And if He died for all, then those who live should **no longer** live for **themselves** but for **Him who** died for them and was raised again. (2 Cor 5:13-15)

I **cleanse myself** from **every** ignoble purpose, making myself an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, **useful to the Master** and prepared to do any good work. I **flee** the evil desires of youth, and pursue **righteousness, faith, love and peace**. (2 Timothy 2:20-22) I have been set free from sin and have become a slave to God. (Rom 6:22) The world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. (Gal 6:14) I **seek first God's kingdom** and **His righteousness**, knowing that I will be given **all** that I need. (Matt 6:33) For the eyes of the Lord range throughout the earth to **strengthen** those whose hearts are **fully committed** to Him. (2 Chronicles 16:9)

BOLDNESS

I give **no opportunity** to the devil (Eph 4:27). I give **no place** to fear in **my life** (I Jn 4:18). That which man fears comes upon him (Job 3:25). Fear has torment (Rev 18:10, I Jn 4:18). The fear of man brings **a snare** (Pr 29:25), but **perfect love** casts out **all** fears (Ps 34:4). God has **not** given me a spirit of fear, **but** a spirit of love, power and a sound mind (2 Tim 1: 7). In righteousness I am established so I'll be **far** from oppression (Isa 54:14). I will not fear or be in terror. It shall not come near me (Ps 91:10). The Lord is **my light** and **my salvation**, whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid (Ps 27: 1)? God is **my refuge** and **my strength**, a **very present help** in trouble (Ps 46: 1-2). Therefore I will not fear.

I have no fear of confrontation. I **boldly** confront the devil. If I were still trying to please men, I should not be a servant of Jesus Christ (Ga 1:10). But I am a servant of the **Most High God**. I fear not, for **He is with me** (Dan 3:26; I Sam 17). I'll **not be dismayed**, for He is my God. He will **strengthen me**; He will **help me**; He will **uphold me** with His **victorious right hand**. (Isa 41: 10)

I'm not ashamed of the gospel for it is the **power of God** unto salvation to **those who believe** (Rom 1:16). I'm a **minister** of reconciliation. I'm an **ambassador** for Jesus Christ. The **anointing** I've received abides in me through Jesus Christ **who loves me** (2 Cor 5:18-20). The anointing **breaks every yoke**. I have **received power** when the Holy Spirit came upon me to be His witness (Acts 1:8). I am a preacher **of righteousness**. His Word which comes out of His mouth **will not return void**, but **will accomplish** His purpose and **prosper** in the thing for which it was sent (Isa 55:11). I know my God; **I am strong**; I will do great exploits (Dan 11:32). As He is, **so am I** in this world (I Jn 4: 17).

I am righteous; therefore, I am **bold** as a lion (Prv 28:1). He will **never** fail me nor forsake me; **therefore** I can boldly say, "The Lord is **my helper**, I'll not be afraid. What can man do to me?" (Heb 13:5-6) I am an **effective evangelist**. I minister **life** and **win souls**. I am a good **communicator**. I am an effective and excellent **teacher**. As a young man or woman, I am strong. The Word of God abides in me and I have **overcome** the evil one (I Jn 2:14). I am an **overcomer** (Rev 2:11).

Greater is He that is **in me** than he that is in the world. I am a hundred-fold Christian (Mk 4:20). I am **complete** in Him (Col 2:10). I am more than a **conqueror** through Christ **who loves me** (Rom 8:37). Grant, Lord, to Your servant **to speak** Your Word with all **boldness** while You stretch out Your hand **to heal and signs and wonders** are performed through the name of Your Holy Servant, Jesus (Acts 4:29-30).

JOY

He gives me **beauty** for ashes, the oil of **joy** for mourning (Isa 61:3). I renounce a spirit of heaviness and put on the **garment of praise** so that He may be glorified. **I will bless** the Lord **at all times**; His praise shall **continually** be in my mouth (Ps34:1). The joy of the Lord is **my strength** (Neh 8:10). **Jesus bore** my grief (Isa 53:4).

This is the day that **the Lord** has made. I will **rejoice and be glad** in it (Ps 118:24). I rejoice with joy **unspeakable** and full of glory. I rejoice in the Lord **always** (Phil 4:4). I do **all things without** grumbling and complaining (Phil 2:14). His words were found, and I ate them, and they became unto me **a joy and delight to my heart** (Jer 15:16). In spite of trials, I offer sacrifices of joy (Ps27:6). I will sing, yes, I will sing praises **unto the Lord**. I have the high praises of God in **my mouth** and a **two-edged sword** in **my hand** (Ps 149:6).

I have set the Lord **always** before me. Because He is at my right hand, **I shall not be moved** (Ps 16:8). Therefore, my heart is **glad** and my soul **rejoices**. My body also dwells **secure** (Ps 16:9). You show me the path of life. At your right hand are **pleasures forever more** (Ps 16:11). I will rejoice in **the Lord**; I will rejoice in the God of my salvation (Ps 35:9). **I wait** upon the Lord, and **He renews** my strength. I will mount up with **wings of eagles**; I will run and **not** be weary; I will walk and **not** faint (Isa 40:31).

FAITH

I can do **all things through Christ** who strengthens me (Phil 4:13). **By my God** I can run against troops and leap over a wall (2 Sam 22:30) He makes my feet like deer's feet; **He makes me** walk upon high places (2 Sam 22:34). With man this is impossible, but with God **all things are possible** (Mat 19:26) All things are possible to **him who believes** (Mark 9:23). If I have faith as a grain of a **mustard seed**, I can say to a mountain, "MOVE," and it **will move**, and **nothing** will be impossible for me (Matt 17:20). I'm a **believer**, I'm not a doubter. **I know** whatever is not of faith is sin (Rom 14:23). I know that **without faith** it is **impossible** to **please God** (Heb 1:6). I know I am to **live by faith** and if I shrink back the Lord has no pleasure in me (Heb 10:38).

Every man and woman is given **a measure** of faith (Rom 12:3). I'll **develop** my faith to the glory of God (Lk 17:5). I have faith towards God (1 Tess 1:18). My faith is not in my faith, but in a **living God** (Dan 6:26), who said He would **never** fail nor forsake me (Deut 31:8). Therefore, I choose to walk **by faith** and not **by sight** (2 Cor 5:7). I trust in the Lord with **all my heart** and I don't lean on my own understanding (Pr 3:5). I'm not ruled by the circumstances, I'm **above** the circumstances. I'm seated with Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6). The steps of a **righteous** man or woman are ordered **by the Lord** (Ps 37:23). Many are the afflictions of the righteous but **the Lord delivers** them out of them **all**. (Ps 34:19).

The righteous man falls seven times, **but rises again** (Pr 24:16). Champions don't give up; they **get up**. One thing I do, forgetting what lies behind, straining forward to what lies ahead, I **press on** toward the goal for the prize of the **upward call** of God in Christ Jesus, my Lord (Phil 3:13-14). I put my hand **to the plow** and **don't look back** (Lk 6:9). The kingdom of heaven comes by violence and those who are violent **take it by force** (Matt 11:12).

It's not by might, nor by power, but **by His Spirit** (Zech 4:6). He ever lives to make **intercession** for me (Heb 7:25). He is able to do **exceedingly far more abundantly** above all that I ever dared **to think or ask**, by the power at work within me (Eph 3:20). He who began a good work in me **will** bring it to **completion** in the day of my Lord Jesus (Phil 1:6).

The memory of the **righteous** is blessed (Pr 10:7). I've been crucified with Christ, nevertheless I live, and the life I now live, I live **by faith** in the Son of God who **loved** me and **gave himself** for me (Ga1 2:20). Whatever is born of God **overcomes** the world (I Jn 5:4). This is the victory that overcomes the world, even **my faith**. Therefore **I am** an overcomer. I'm going from faith **to faith**, strength **to strength**, glory **to glory** (2Cor3: 18). The path of the righteous is like the **light of dawn** that shines brighter and **brighter** until the full day (Pr 4:18). I **humble myself** under His mighty hand that **He may** lift me up **in due time** (I Pet 5:6).

FRUITFUL IN MINISTRY

Jesus has **chosen** me and **appointed** me to go and **bear** fruit-fruit that will last. (Jn 15:16) Christ is the vine; I am the branch. If I **remain** in Him and He in me, I **will bear** much fruit. Apart from Him I can do **nothing**. If I remain in Him and His words remain in me, I can ask whatever I wish, and it **will be given** to me. This is to the Father's glory, that I bear **much fruit**, showing myself to be His disciple. (Jn 15:5-8)

All authority in heaven and on earth has been **given to Jesus**. Therefore I will go and make disciples of **all nations**. (Matt 28:18-19) I will be fruitful and **multiply**. (Gen 1:28) The things that I have learned I will entrust to **reliable** men who will also be qualified to **teach others**. (2 Tim 2:2) I am obligated to all men and am eager to preach the gospel **wherever** I go. I am **not ashamed** of the gospel, because it is the **power of God** for the salvation of **everyone** who believes. (Rom 1:14-16) All over the world this gospel **is bearing fruit** and **growing**. (Col 1:6)

I will not become weary in doing good, for at the **proper time** I will **reap a harvest** if I do not give up. Therefore, as I have **opportunity**, I will do good to **all people**. (Gal 6:9-10) I will stand firm and let **nothing** move me, always giving myself **fully** to the work of the Lord, because I know that my labor in the Lord is **not in vain**. (1 Cor 15:58) If I sow in tears, I will reap with songs of joy. (Psa 126:5) Even if I am the least I will become **a thousand**; even if I am the smallest I will become a **mighty nation**. In the **proper time**, the Lord **will do this** swiftly. (Isa 60:22)

DESTINY

I **expect** God to do great things in me and the church. The eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth in order to **show Himself strong** on behalf of those **whose hearts** are fully blameless towards Him (2 Chron 16:9). God rewards those who **diligently seek** Him (Heb 11:6). He who calls me is **faithful**, and He will do it (1 Thess 5:24).

I'm **not** lukewarm. I'm **not** a compromiser (Rev3: 16). I'll **not** be conformed to this world (Rom 12:2). I'm **not** a loser; I'm a **winner**. I'm a **partaker** of His divine nature (2 Pet 1: 4). God indwells my body (1 Jn 4:13). I run the race **to win** (1Cor9:24). His grace is **sufficient** for me. His power is made **perfect** in my weakness (2 Cor 12:9).

When the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will **raise up** a standard (1sa 59:19). **I'm part** of that standard. We are the soldiers of the army of salvation that God is raising up to save the world. **I'll not** despise the day of small beginnings (Zech 4:5). We will **reclaim** that which the thief has stolen through tradition and ignorance. The earth is the **Lord's** and the fullness thereof, the world and **all** who dwell therein (Ps 24:1-2). He said He would pour out **His Spirit** in these last days. Sons and daughters would **prophecy**; young men would **see visions**; old men would **dream dreams** (Joel 2:28).

I'm part of this end-time vision, for without it I will perish (Pr 29:18). For still the vision awaits its time, it hastens to the end; **it will not fail**. If it seems slow, **I will wait** for it. It will surely **come**. It will not delay. Therefore, **I have a destiny** (Hab 2:3). Jesus is restoring the church. He is coming back for a glorious church **without** spot or wrinkle or blemish or any such things (Eph 5:27). It will be a **triumphant** church. I will **kick in** the gates of hell. I'm part of this end-time move. God is in work in me to will and to work for **His good pleasure** (Phil 2:13).

The Lord will fulfill His purpose for me (Ps 138:8). There are different kinds of working or operation of the gifts but the **same God** works **all of them** in all men so He works them all in me as **the Spirit** wills (1 Cor 12:6).

I'm a pioneer, I'm not a settler. I'm on the **front lines**. I've **counted** the cost. I'll **pay** the price (Lk 14:26-33).

I'm **giving** my utmost for His highest. I press on toward the goal for the **prize** of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus, my Lord (Php 3:14). I'm out to change **my generation**. I'm beginning today. I redeem the time. My ministry is **maturing**. My life is taking on new responsibilities.

Boldly, I can approach the throne of grace to receive **mercy** and **grace** for help in the time of need. I'll be anxious for **nothing** (Phil 4:6). He will keep me in **perfect peace** for my mind is stayed **on Him** (Isa 26:3). Therefore, I enter **His rest** (Heb 4:3). I have the **mind** of Christ (1 Cor 2:16). I'm not weighed down by the cares of this life (2Tim2:4). I cast **my cares** on the Lord (1 Pet 5:7).

Whatever the task this day, I'll do it **heartily** as serving the Lord (Co1 3:23). I'll **pursue** excellence, for I serve a God of **excellence** (Dan 6:3). I **stir up** the gifts within me. I'll **step out** in faith. I'll **move** in the supernatural. I'll set the captives **free** (Isa 61:1). I don't lack **any** spiritual gift as I **eagerly wait** for our Lord Jesus to be revealed (1 Cor 1:7).

The Spirit of the Lord is upon **me**. He has **anointed** me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim **release** to the captives, **recovery** of sight to the blind, to **set at liberty** those who are oppressed, to **bind up** the brokenhearted, and **proclaim** the acceptable year of the Lord (Isa 61:1-2). I'll not limit the Holy One of Israel. I'll **not be disobedient** to the heavenly vision. The kingdoms of this world shall become the kingdoms of **our God** and **His Christ** (Rev 11:15).

OVERCOMING FEAR & WALKING IN BOLDNESS

The Lord is my **light** and my **salvation**-whom shall I fear? The Lord is the **stronghold** of my life-of whom shall I be afraid? When evil men advance against me to devour my flesh, when my enemies and my foes attack me, they will **stumble and fall**. Though an army besieges me, my heart will **not fear** though war break out against me, even then will I be **confident**. (Ps 27:1-3) God has not given me a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of **power** of **love** and of **self-discipline**. (2 Tim 1:7) Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for **You are with me**; Your rod and Your staff, they **comfort** me. (Ps 23:4)

I say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I **trust**." (Ps 91:2) A thousand may fall at my side, ten thousand at my right hand, but it **will not** come near me. (Ps 91:7) I make the Most High my dwelling. Therefore, **no harm** will befall me; **no disaster** will come near my house. For God will command His angels concerning me, to guard me in **all my ways**; they will lift me up in their **hands**, so that I will not strike my foot against a stone. I will tread upon the lion and the cobra; I will **trample** the great lion and the serpent. (Ps 91:9-13) I have **no fear** of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, for the Lord is my **confidence** and will keep my foot from being snared. (Pr 3:25-26)

I have not received a spirit that makes me a slave again to fear, but I have received the Spirit of **sonship**. (Rom 8:15) By Jesus' death I am **set free** from the fear of death. (Heb 2:14-15) I will not fear what the world fears. I will not be frightened. In **my heart**, I set apart Christ **as Lord**. (1 Pet 3:14-15) Because of God's perfect love for me, I will not live in fear. (1 Jn 4:18) The Lord is my helper; **I will not be afraid**. What can man do to me? (Heb 13:6) I will not be afraid of anything I may suffer. I will be **faithful**, even to the point of death, knowing that Jesus will give me a **crown of life**. (Rev 2:10)

Because I am righteous, I am as **bold** as a lion. (Pr 28:1) I am **not ashamed** of the gospel, because it is the **power** of God for the salvation of **everyone** who believes. (Rom 1:16) I will not be ensnared by the fear of man. (Pr 29:25) If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a **servant** of Christ. (Gal 1:10) I will call to the Lord who makes me **bold** and **strong-hearted**. (Ps 138:3)

I will be **strong** and **courageous**. I will not be terrified; I will not be discouraged, for the Lord my God will be with me **wherever I go**. (Joshua 1:9) **No weapon** formed against me will prosper. (Isa 54:17) Thanks be to God! He **gives** me the victory through **my Lord** Jesus Christ. (1 Cor 15:57)

RIGHT THINKING

I love God's Word. I meditate on it **all day long**. His commands make me **wiser** than my enemies, for they are **ever with me**. I have more insight than all my teachers, for I **meditate** on His statutes. I have more **understanding** than the elders, for I **obey God's precepts**. I have not departed from God's laws, for He Himself has taught me. (Ps 119:97-100,102)

I will love the Lord my God with **all my mind**. (Mk 12:30) I will conform no longer to the pattern of this world. I will be **transformed** by the renewing of my mind so that I will be able to **test and approve** what God's will is-His good, pleasing and perfect will. (Rom 12:2) Because I have the Spirit of God, I will make **right judgments** about all things-for I have the **mind of Christ**. (1 Cor 2:15-16) The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is **life and peace**. (Rom 8:6) I will not be anxious about **anything**, but in everything, by prayer and petition, **with thanksgiving**, I will present my requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, **will guard** my heart and my mind in Christ Jesus. (Phil 4:6-7)

My heart is **not proud**. I do not concern myself with great matters or things too wonderful for me. But I have **stilled** and **quieted** my soul. (Ps 131:1-2) I take captive **every thought** to make it **obedient** to Christ. (2 Cor 10:5) I am not wise in my own eyes. (Pr 3:7) But **I trust** in **the Lord** with all my heart and lean not on my own understanding. (Pr 3:5)

IDENTITY IN CHRIST

God is not a man that He should lie. Therefore, whatever He says about me is **true**. (Num 23:19) God has blessed me with **every** spiritual blessing through His Son Jesus Christ. Before **the creation** of the world he chose me to be **holy and blameless** in His sight. In love He predestined me to be adopted as His son through Jesus Christ. God has **lavished** His grace on me and I am redeemed and forgiven. I have been **marked** in Christ with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit who is a deposit **guaranteeing** my **eternal inheritance**. Because of God's **abundant** goodness, I will live for the praise of **His glory**. (Eph 1:3-14)

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ **lives in me**. (Gal 2:20) I have been **washed**, I have been **sanctified**, I have been **justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of God. (1 Cor 6:11) I am a **new** creation; the old has **gone**, the new has **come!** (2Cor 5:17) I am the righteousness of God. (2 Cor 5:21) I have been **set free** from sin and have become a slave to **righteousness**. (Rom 6:18) I am God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared **in advance** for me to do. (Eph 2:20) There is **no longer** any condemnation for me because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life has **set me free** from the law of sin and death. (Rom 8:1-2) Because the Son has set me free, I am **free indeed**. (Jn 8:36)

I have been **born again**, not of perishable seed, but of **imperishable**, through the living and enduring word of God. (1 Pet 1:23) Because I am born of God, I **will overcome** the world. (1 Jn 5:4) I am part of a **chosen** people, a **royal priesthood**, a **holy nation**, and I **belong** to God. (1 Pet 2:9) I know God and He knows me. (Gal 4:9) He has **lavished** His love on me and called me a **child of God**. (1 Jn 3:1) When Christ appears, I will be **like Him**. (1 Jn 3:2) Christ is not ashamed to call me His brother. (Heb 2:11) Even while I was God's enemy, **Christ died for me**. (Rom 5:8) **Nothing** will be able to separate me from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus my Lord. (Rom 8:39)

I am **no longer** a foreigner, but a fellow **citizen** with God's people and a member of **God's household**. (Eph 2:19) My citizenship is in heaven. (Phil. 3:20)

The Spirit Himself **testifies** with my spirit that I am God's child. And since I am God's child, I am also **an heir**-an heir of God and a **coheir** with Christ. (Rom

8:16-17) I am not just Christ's servant, I am His **friend**. (Jn 15:16) According to God's word I am **strong**, the word of God **lives** in me, and I **have** overcome the evil one. (1 Jn 2:14) I am more than a **conqueror**. (Rom 8:37) God did not give me a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of **power**, of **love** and of **self-discipline**. (2 Timothy 1:7) Thanks be to God! He gives me the **victory** through my Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor 15:57)

PURITY

I make a **covenant** with my eyes not to look at anyone lustfully. (Job 31:1) I will not commit adultery in **my heart**. (Matt 5:28) I will keep my hands **clean** and my heart **pure** so that I may ascend the hill of the Lord and **stand** in His holy place. (Ps 24:3-4) I will not allow **a hint** of sexual immorality to be in my life. (Eph 5:3) I will set before my eyes **no vile thing**. (Ps 101:3)

My body is **not** meant for sexual immorality. It is meant for **the Lord**. My body is a member of Christ himself. Therefore, **I will never** use it for ungodly activity. My body is a **temple** of the Holy Spirit, who is in me. I am **not my own**; I was **bought** at a price. Therefore, I will honor God with **my body**. (1 Cor 6:13-20) I will also honor the covenant of marriage and keep the marriage bed **pure**. (Heb 13:4) Above all things, I will **guard** my heart, for it is the **wellspring** of life. (Pr 4:23)

I will set an example for others in **speech**, in **life**, in **love**, in **faith** and in **purity**. (1 Timothy 4:12) I will not allow any unwholesome talk to come out of **my mouth**, but only what is **helpful** for building others up according to **their** needs. (Eph 4:29) **I will** put away perversity from my **mouth** and keep corrupt talk far from my **lips**. (Pr 4:24)

POWER, MIRACLES & HEALING

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has **anointed** me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim **freedom** for the prisoners and **recovery** of sight for the blind, to **release** the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's **favor**. (Lk 4:18-19) My prayers are **powerful and effective**. Elijah was a man just like me. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, **and it did not rain** on the land for three and a half years. Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops. (James 5:16-18) **Everything** is possible for him who believes. (Mark 9:23)

Because of my faith in Jesus, I will do the things that He did while on the earth. I will do even **greater things**. I may ask Jesus for anything in His name, and **He will do it**. (Jn 14:12-14) Because I believe, these signs will accompany me: In Jesus' name I will **drive out** demons; I will **speak** in new tongues; I will place my hands on sick people, and they will **get well**. (Mark 16:17-18)

I pray that the eyes of my heart may be **continually enlightened** in order that I may know God's **incomparably great** power for us who believe. That power is like the working of His mighty strength, which **He exerted** in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at **His right hand** in the heavenly realms, far above **all** rule and authority, power and dominion, and **every** title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. (Eph 1:18-21) I have this **treasure** in a jar of clay to show that this **all-surpassing** power is from God and not from me. (2 Cor 4:7)

I will praise the Lord with **all of my being**, and will forget none of His benefits that He **forgives** all my sins and **heals** all my diseases; that He **redeems** my life from the pit and **crowns** me with love and compassion; that He **satisfies** my desires with **good things** so that my youth is **renewed** like an eagle. (Ps 103:2-5)

Now, Lord, consider the threats of those who don't know You and **enable** Your servants to speak Your word with great **boldness**. Stretch out Your hand to heal and perform **miraculous** signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant **Jesus**. (Acts 4:29-30)

INTIMACY WITH GOD

I love the house where **You live**, O Lord, the place where Your glory dwells. (Ps 26:8) One thing I ask of the Lord, this is what I seek: **that I may dwell** in the house of the Lord **all** the days of my life, to **gaze** upon the beauty of the Lord and to **seek** Him in His temple. (Ps 27:4) My heart says of You, 'Seek His face!' Your face, Lord, **I will seek**. (Ps 27:8) As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for You, O God. My soul **thirsts** for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God? (Ps 42:1-2) I have seen You in the sanctuary and beheld Your **power** and Your **glory**. Because Your love is **better than life**, my lips will glorify' You. I will praise You as long as I live, and in **Your name** I will lift up my hands. (Ps 63:2-4)

How **lovely** is Your dwelling place, O Lord Almighty! My soul **yearns**, even **faints**, for the courts of the Lord; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. (Ps 84:1-2) Better is **one day** in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a **doorkeeper** in the house of **my God** than dwell in the tents of the wicked. (Ps 84:10)

I do not live on bread alone but on **every word** that comes from the mouth of the **Lord**. (Deut 8:3) I will **not depart** from the commands of God's lips; I **treasure** the words of His mouth **more** than my daily bread. (Job 23:12) When God's words come, I will eat them; they are **my joy** and **my heart's delight**, for I bear the name of the Lord God **Almighty**. (Jer 15:16)

I will **listen** to the voice of Jesus. As He calls me and leads me, I will **follow** Him, because I know His voice. (Jn 10:3-5) I love Jesus and will **obey** Him; **He loves me** and will show Himself to me. He and the Father will come and **make their home** with me. (Jn 14:21, 23) No longer do I relate to God on the basis of the experience of others. **Instead**, whether I am the least or the greatest, I myself **will know God**. (Jeremiah 3 1:34) Because Jesus has gone before me, I will approach God's throne with **confidence**. (Heb 4:16) As I come near to God, He will come near to me. (James 4:8) Though I was once far away, I have been **brought near** to God through the **blood of Christ**. (Eph 2:13) Jesus Himself dwells in my heart through **faith**. (Eph 3:17) He will be with me **always**, to the very end of the age. (Matt 28:20)

PROVISION & GENEROSITY

I **renounce** the love of money, which is a root of **all kinds** of evil. (1Tim 6:10) Instead I store up for myself treasures **in heaven**. For where my treasure is, there **my heart** will be also. (Matt 6:19-21) I **cannot serve** both God and money. (Matt 6:24) I will use worldly wealth to invest **in people**, so that when it is gone, I will have relationships with **eternal significance**. (Luk 16:9) I will be **trustworthy** in handling money so that I **can be trusted** with true riches. (Luk 16:11)

I **will not rob God** in tithes and offerings. I **will always give** my **whole tithe**. As I test Gods promise, **He will** throw open the **floodgates** of heaven and pour out **so much** blessing that I will not have room enough for it. Others will look at me and **call me blessed**. (Mal 3:8-12)

It **is not** my power or the strength of my hands that produces wealth for me. It is **the Lord** my God who gives me the **ability to produce** wealth. (Deut 8:17-18) **As I obey** God's commands, I will be blessed **wherever** I go. My **children** will be blessed. My **home** will be blessed. My **career** will be blessed. **I** will be blessed when I **come in** and blessed when I **go out**. (Deut 28:3-6)

I will be **generous** and give to others, knowing that a good **measure** will be given to me. For with the measure **I use**, it will be **measured to me**. (Luke 6:38)

I will refresh **others** and will myself be refreshed. (Pr 11:25) I **will sow** into others generously, knowing that I **will reap** generously. (2 Cor 9:6) I will give **cheerfully, not reluctantly or under compulsion**, for God loves a cheerful giver. (2 Cor 9:7) And God will make **all grace** abound to me, so that in **all things at all times**; having all that I need, I will abound in **every** good work. (2 Cor 9:8)

As I live to produce a harvest of **righteousness**, I will be made rich in **every way** so that I can be generous on **every occasion** with the result that **others** will give thanks **to God**. (2 Cor 9:11)

I do not consider godliness to be a means to financial gain. But godliness with **contentment** is great gain. (1 Tim 6:5-6) I **will learn** the secret of being content in **any and every** situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do **everything** through Him who gives me **strength**. (Phil 4:12-13) My God will meet **all my needs** according to His **glorious riches** in Christ Jesus. (Phil 4:19)
